The Toile de Jouy Museum welcomes fashion designers after inviting interior designers to a “Carte blanche”

Designers and established fashion houses exhibit their creations, all of which were inspired by their common passion for the famous Toile de Jouy ...

This new exhibition is partly the result of commissioned fashion professionals to produce a toile de Jouy creation and partly to show existing pieces on loan from fashion houses and accessories designers who have been inspired by Toile de Jouy.

Famous designer Philippe Model encourages us to discover the exhibition MODE IN JOUY; positioned on the corner of a street and visible through boutique like windows.

Fashion houses such as Jean-Charles de Castelbajac, Christian Dior, Gianfranco Ferré, Diane von Furstenberg, Mademoiselle Lucien Exclusive, Chantal Thomass, Versace as well as labels such as Laura Ashley, New Look, La Bagagerie, Aubade, Pollopel Bags, Yazbukey lend their unique toile de Jouy creations and let the general public discover wonders never exhibited before.

MODE IN JOUY plunges us back into the quintessence of the Toile de Jouy which, despite common knowledge, in the XVIIIth century was used as much for interior design as for clothing.

A visit through the museums' permanent display will give you the opportunity to bridge a gap between textiles printed at Jouy-en-Josas during the time of its creator Christophe-Philippe Oberkampf, and reprints from nowadays, in partnership with various fabric editors.

The MODE IN JOUY exhibition focusses on the fashion spirit of Toile de Jouy by presenting contemporary creations. Don't miss this fantastic exhibition at the Toile de Jouy Museum.
